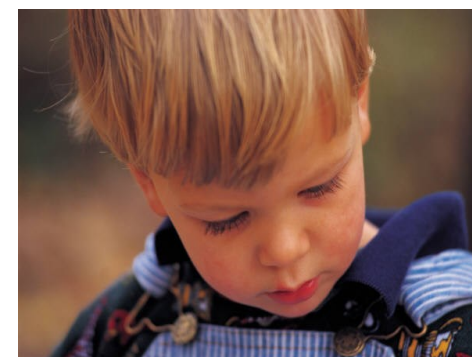

The Autism Spectrum group offers support and education to parents raising children with Autism, Asperger's Syndrome and other Pervasive Developmental Disorders.
